Additional recitals include appearances at the Princeton Music Club, the Cheekwood Museum of Art in Nashville, the Hornby Island Recital Series in Victoria, B.C., the MET Performing Arts Center in Spokane, the John Addison Cultural Arts Recital Series in Washington D.C., the Lake Chelan Bach Feste as well as the Merc Playhouse Theatre. He has also presented concerts of the complete works for Cello and Piano by Beethoven and over twenty cycles performing all Six Bach Suites. He will be accompanied on the organ by Mark Andersen, the 2009 artist-in-residence.
